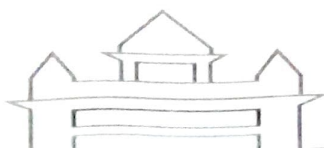



Report presented by General Secretary AABHA in the Annual General Body Meeting held on 17.01.2020

1. There were 39 meetings of the local executive body held during the year to discuss the various issues related to the AABHA.
2. Foundation stone of AABHA guest house was laid by Prof. V.K. Shukla, Rector, Banaras Hindu University and Shri M. Venkataramaiah, our alumnus and founder of Nuziveedu Seeds, Hyderabad on 19 April 2019.
3. An Alumni Cell started functioning in the office of the Director, Institute of Agricultural Sciences.
4. The Architectural Design of AABHA Guest house was prepared by M/s Kapoor & Sons, a reputed Architect of Varanasi.
5. The structural design of AABHA Guest House was prepared by Prof. V. Kumar, of IIT, BHU.
6. A tentative estimate was taken from M/s Agrawal & Sons, and M/s Vinay Associates with the view to have an idea about the expenditure incurred in construction of guest house.
7. The AABHA executive meeting also passed a proposal to contact UWD, BHU to prepare the bill of quantity so that tendering process could be started.
8. The AABHA executive committee passed a resolution to transfer the alumni money lying in BGT Hostel and SRK Hostel. The alumni money of both the hostels has been transferred in the AABHA account.
9. Recently a team of the AABHA executive body under the leadership of AABHA Chairman Prof. Ramesh Chand, Director, I.Ag.Sciences, BHU participated in the meeting of Bihar regional chapter held at Patna on 12.01.2020. The Bihar chapter has contributed around 6.0 Lakhs for the construction of AABHA guest house.
10. Amendment in the Memorandum of Association of AABHA was necessary to make its objective broader to include the farmer training and socio economic welfare so that private companies may be contacted for CSR fund for the construction of guest house.
11. Effort is on to seek the income tax exemption from the competent authority.
12. We have started a tradition of felicitating our alumni visiting first time in the Institute. In this endeavor, more than 20 alumni have been felicitated.
13. The total balance in AABHA account is Rs1,11,40,586/- out of this a sum of Rs.86,32,428/- has been collected for the construction of AABHA guest house.
